CONEY ISLAND DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

Since its formation, Coney Island Development Corporation (CIDC) has spearheaded the creation of a comprehensive planning process for the future of Coney Island. In addition to its work on a rezoning framework that will move development in Coney Island forward, CIDC, in partnership with various City agencies, has already begun to fulfill its important mission through a series of exciting community-based development projects.

Steeplechase Plaza

This freshly-designed, new waterfront public plaza on the Boardwalk, will tie together the best of the area with open space, retail, and a water feature.

B&B Carousell

The last of Coney Island's historic carousels is being completely restored and will be relocated as the focal point of Steeplechase Plaza.

Parachute Jump

This iconic monument on the Boardwalk has been reconstructed and refurbished and is being illuminated once again to shine as "Brooklyn's Eiffel Tower."

Boardwalk

Coney Island's Riegelmann Boardwalk is now the subject of an extensive study which will inform a full redesign of this classic pedestrian thoroughfare.

Community Center

Construction of the Coney Island Community Center, the first YMCA in South Brooklyn, will provide much-needed community space and public amenities for local residents.

Aquarium

Major upgrades are planned for the New York Aquarium, an anchor institution in the heart of the entertainment district.

District Maintenance

Street sanitation services throughout the summer season help to improve the Coney Island experience for both residents and visitors.
